



HISTORIC TOUR Retreat Itinerary

Thursday - Check-in

- 3:00 PM - 5:00 PM: Early check-ins get settled into your room and then head over to Bluff Fort to learn about the history of the town. Enjoy delicious homemade pioneer-style treats and ice cream while learning about the region's rich history.
- 6:00 PM: Catered pizza buffet dinner (Food restriction friendly) + trip orientation.
- 7:00 PM: Get to know you game night! Connect with like-minded people who have joined the retreat!

Friday

- 7:00 AM: Early Start! Breakfast at Cedar Shack Cafe
- 8:00 AM: Head to Edge of the Cedars Historic Museum. View the largest collection of Ancestral Puebloan (Anasazi) pottery on display in the Four Corners region and explore an authentic Puebloan village.
- 10:00 AM: Explore San Juan through the ages at The Dinosaur Museum, where the complete history of the world of dinosaurs is presented. Blanding forms the extreme southern tip of what is called the "Dinosaur Diamond," a hotbed of prehistoric dinosaur activity and fossil finds
- 11:00 AM: Lunch Picnic at the Visitor Center park. Boxed lunches are provided! Take a quick look inside the Visitor Center to gather information and look over their small-scale museum. Great information and clean restrooms make it the perfect stop along our route before hitting the road again.
- 12:00 PM: Head to Hovenweep National Monument. Once home to over 2,500 people, Hovenweep includes six prehistoric villages built between 1200 - 1300 A.D. Explore a variety of structures, including multistory towers perched on canyon rims and balanced on boulders. A mild 2-mile loop trail hike will get you moving and give you plenty to admire as you ponder the challenges that were faced in these cliff dwellings.
- 6:00 PM: Catered Steak Dinner back at the Resort (food restriction friendly)
- 7:00 PM: Soak stargaze and socialize in our oversized outdoor hot tub.

Saturday

- 8:00 AM: Breakfast at the Cafe
- 9:00 AM Meet at the Front Desk for an all-day adventure. Wild Expeditions River and Hummer Tour, This combination tour includes the best of two of our favorite trips meshed into one amazing day on the San Juan. You'll float 8 miles paddling your own kayak or jump in a tandem with someone you love. Two short easy hikes will take you to one of the largest rock art panels in North America and a 1000 year old cliff dwelling.
